

How to get to Hostería Pantaví

Public transportation

COOPERATIVA URCUQUI

Departs the Ibarra Terminal every 30 minutes but make sure the bus follows this route: Urcuqui, Tumbabiro, Pablo Arenas, Cahuasqui. Buses operate from 6 am to 6 pm.

The cooperative offers a special service that leaves at 4pm from the Ibarra Terminal. This route passes through Salinas and the entrance of the hostel at around 17:10 pm. Note that this bus only departs 1x per day at the indicated time.

COOPERATIVA BUENOS AIRES:

Departs the Ibarra Terminal every 30 minutes.

The ticket with either cooperative costs USD 0.95 in 2019 /2020

TAXI from the Ibarra bus terminal:

From any location in Ibarra, you can take a taxi to the hostel. For clients that travel from Quito or Tulcán, you can take a taxi directly from the bus terminal in Ibarra.

The route is through Urcuqui or Salinas. In total, the ride lasts aprox 35 – 40 minutes to reach the hostel. Estimated rate: USD 15 per transfer.

Those that wish to return to the Ibarra Terminal to continue on your journey by public transport can call a taxi from the hostel.

Payment is made in cash directly to the taxi driver.
